National Veterinary Research Institute (PIWet), together with Federal Institute for Risk Assessment (BfR) is organising Winter School for young scientists financed by the Vet-Twin project. The topics of the event include:

The eligible candidates:

- CV with a list of research papers and other scientific achievements,
- summary of scientific interests,
- motivation letter describing how the participation in the event will influence researcher's scientific career;
- a copy of a document with a birth date.

The successful candidates will be informed by November, 3rd.
